

A EUROPEAN INNOVATION PARTNERSHIP FOR PRACTICE-ORIENTED AND FUTURE-PROOF FARMING AND FORESTRY



The European Innovation Partnership for Agricultural Productivity and Sustainability (EIP-AGRI) was launched by the European Commission in 2012, as one of five European Innovation Partnerships.

Aim: To foster a competitive and sustainable agriculture and forestry sector that "achieves more from less".

Future-proof: take advantage of new opportunities, but also prepare for challenges that arise.

• The EIP-AGRI bridges the gaps between research and practice in agriculture, forestry and agribusiness, and encourages sharing innovative ideas and solutions, to put them into practice.

Building up a well-functioning Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation Systems at EU level (CCO)

Fostering a smart and resilient agricultural sector and food security:

- SO1 Support viable farm income and resilience across the EU territory to enhance food security
- **SO2** Enhance **market orientation** and increase **competitiveness** including greater focus on research, technology and digitalisation
- SO3 Improve farmers' position in the value chain

- SO9 Improve the response of EU agriculture to societal demands on food and health, including safe, nutritious and sustainable food, as well as animal welfare














Challenges and opportunities by development directions of operational group




