Evidence of success & Potential for learning or transfer

- Constantly growing numbers of Food Startups in the Incubator (19 Startups right now)
- The FSIWS has 50% female founders, which is highly successful, since the average is only 16% in Germany
- The e-learning platform Moodle has over 800 registrations
- Within 2 years the FSIWS launched three different initiatives:
 - The hospitality initiative (80 participants)
 - Farmers initiative (240 participants)
 - How to become a female founder (80 participants in 2022)
