What are Innovation Vouchers?



Innovation vouchers are small lines of credit (usually ranging from $\in 2,000$ to $\in 20,000$) provided by regional or national governments to Small- and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs) to purchase services from knowledge providers such as universities, research centres, or consulting firms with a view to introducing new products, processes, or services in their business operations.

Innovation vouchers have three main objectives:

- To stimulate the introduction of product, process, organisational or service innovation in SMEs,
- To promote university-industry collaboration and stimulate knowledge transfer.
- To foster the formation of networks between SMEs and other academic, research and private partners.
