



As an InvestEU Implementing Partner, we are charged with deploying a further €6.5bn to the market, with various policy priorities at the forefront of our investment strategy.







Applications will go through four steps



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
InvestEU guarantee products overview

### Capped versus uncapped guarantees

### Guarantee products
