The importance of policy experimentations

- Regions are encouraged to experiment with new policies to promote the green and digital twin transitions (<u>Radosevic et al.</u>).
- Policy experimentation involves testing new policies on a small scale, measuring their impact, and learning from the results to scale up successful solutions. This approach has not been widely used in research and innovation policy, hindering Europe's progress in this area.
- The European Commission Directorate-General for Research and Innovation (DG RTD) has launched the <u>Policy Experimentation project</u> to inform and integrate policy experimentation into EU research and innovation policy-making.
- Regions and municipalities possess the adaptability to tackle local issues and involve their communities, making them ideal for driving policy experiments.
- Engaging in policy experimentation necessitates risk-taking and the involvement of entrepreneurial-minded entities and policy entrepreneurs.
