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Interreg Europe objective

To improve regional development policies through the identification and transfer of good practices among EU regions

Helps policymakers to find new solutions to their challenges

 (700+ from Ukraine)









Peer review step-by-step

Application

Submit your **policy** challenge through the online form.

Preparation

Draft a **background paper** to describe your context and background in more detail.






Targeted call to community members to select relevant peers.

Peer review

Two-day meeting among the beneficiary, its stakeholders and the peers.



Platform experts and peers work together to propose tailored policy recommendations.

Follow-up

Final report with the conclusions, roadmap and timeline.





Interview with the beneficiary on the results of the peer review.

Beneficiary

Review of the application by the expert team.

Fast tracking Renewable Energy Communities



Cyprus Energy Agency

Peers from: Austria, Belgium, Germany

Recommendations:

- Local authorities are natural allies for local RECs: they can express political support, and use power of tendering
- As the project initiator the Energy Agency can identify pilot village
- RECs can help keep electricity generation and consumption at local level




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
