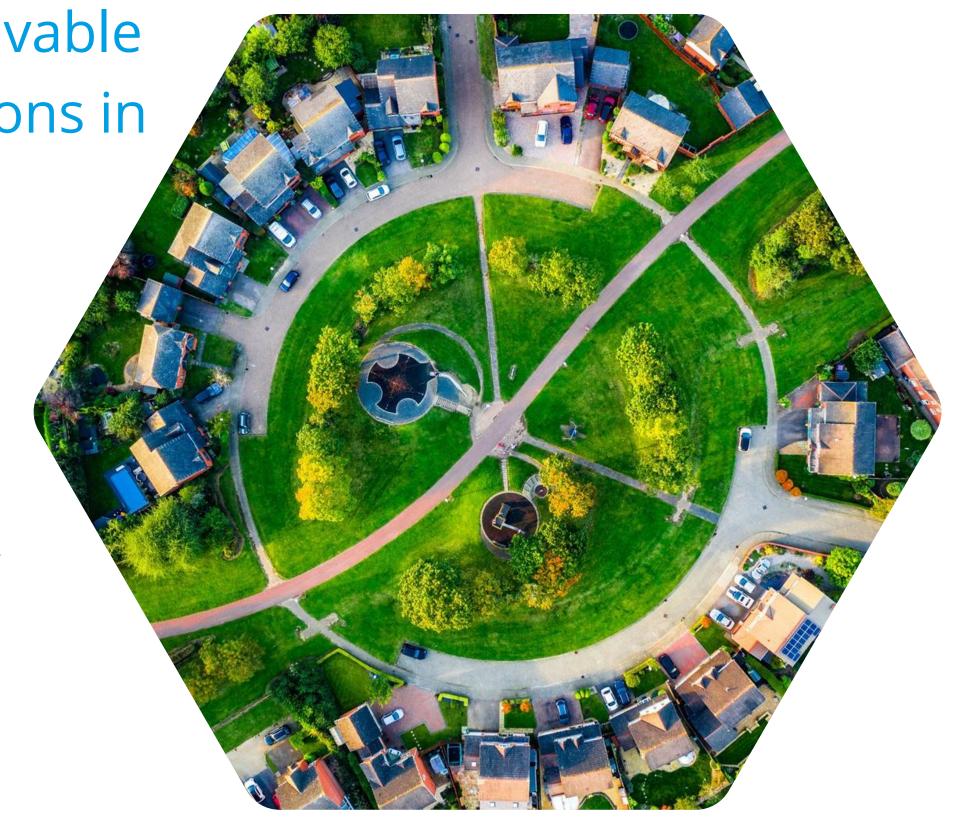

The origins of PROXIMITIES

- Reggio Emilia's attention to periurban/peripheral areas from other EU projects: connections between inner city - external areas mainly approached from a mobility perspective
- General Urban Plan of Reggio Emilia describing the 2030 City's vision on urban planning, agriculture, climate, sustainability, social and economic development. The Plan implemented studies and analysis on 15-minute city concept, but without a cross-sectoral focus
- Need to strengthen the concept of proximity by considering the distance to services as an element for the quality of life
- Covid emergency showed the vital role of neighbourhood services to provide basic functions (economic, social, environmental.)

"PROXIMITIES investigates peripheral areas on multiple territorial levels (city/regional) and dimensions (social/economic/environmental) to find public common approaches to restore centrality of neighbourhood dimension, people-centred, place-based solutions. It tackles cross-sectorial policy solutions to redesign urban peripheral areas as sustainable & resilient places and communities."

PROXIMITIES Common assumptions

- EU peripheral urban areas, regardless of their configuration, experience **lower concentration of services/opportunities** for citizens
- The EU trend of implementing 15-min approaches on inner centers worsened the possibility for peripheral urban areas to reach a **people-center dimension in terms of urban spaces, access to services, livability and quality of life**
- Covid period showed the importance of investing on **Proximity and relationships** to improve social capital, cultural opportunities, connections with inner areas
- Integrated vision of "proximity" as a way to broaden the discussion on "15-minutes city" by integrating social, economic, environmental, landscape, governance challenges
- **New models of governance**, multi-stakeholder process and co-planning of interventions in peripheral areas by engaging local authorities, social actors, cultural actors, business, services, neighborhood/citizen associations

PROXIMITIES Leverages

- **Proximity economy** leverage on trade, crafts, farms by focusing on the multifunctionality of services to generate social, environmental and economic value
- **Sustainable mobility** bring people back to the center, strengthen the connections between the suburbs and the urban center and improve the livability and attractiveness of peripheral areas (in particular focused on walkability and cycling)
- Quality of public spaces and livability resilience and naturalness of urban environments, care of green and blue spaces, quality of public spaces
- **Social dimension** community involvement, recreation of social ties, youth engagement, integration of public proximity services
- **Governance and territorial services** building new partnerships between local authorities, businesses, social and cultural actors, citizens associations to make peripheral areas places of community regeneration and socio-economic innovation

PROXIMITIES Objectives

- To include peripheral areas in strategic planning as key "driver" for sustainable city development
- To increase policy makers and stakeholders' capacities to implement an integrated vision to the sustainable development of peripheral urban area, according to the 5 PROXIMITIES leverages
- To **change citizens' mindset** about peripheral urban area towards livable places of community regeneration, socio-economic innovation and environmental promotion
- To investigate and compare different scenarios of peripheral urban areas in Europe, contributing to the assessment of their specific evolutions across EU regions

PROXIMITIES Target

- Policy makers at local and regional level
- Partners' staff members engagement of relevant departments: urban planning, participation policies, welfare policies, green/sustainability..
- Peripheral urban stakeholders- retailers, CSOs, schools, community centers, associations, service providers, business associations, universities, research centers..
- Citizens
- EU policy makers and technicians

PROXIMITIES Expected results

- Identification of at least 24 Good Practices from 8 countries
- Interregional exchange learning process based on study visit and knowldge exchange sessions
- Improvement of 7 policy instruments according to project's learnings
- Improvement of 48 organizations' capacity thanks to their participation in the project
- Dissemination of project's results and findings
