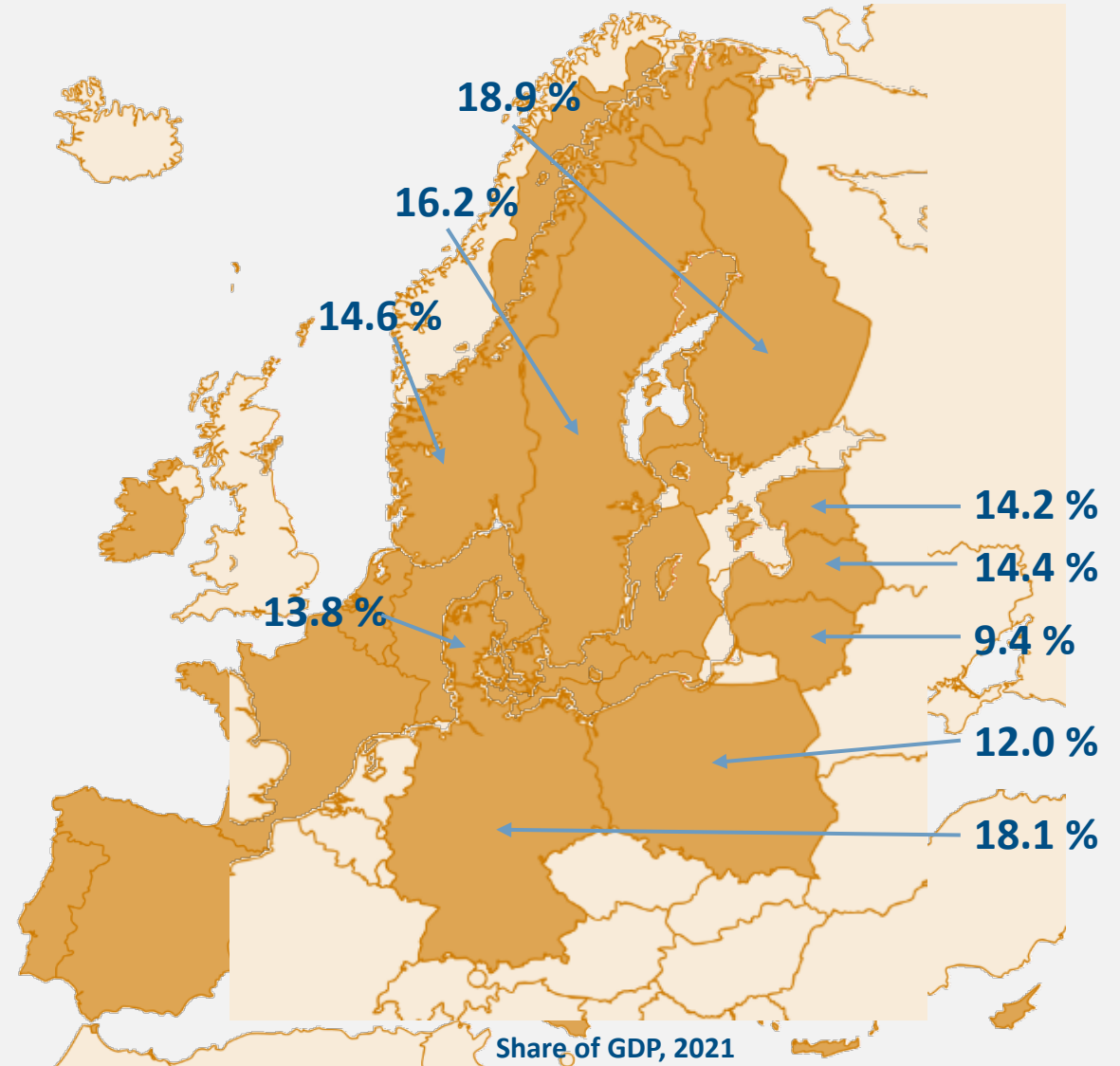

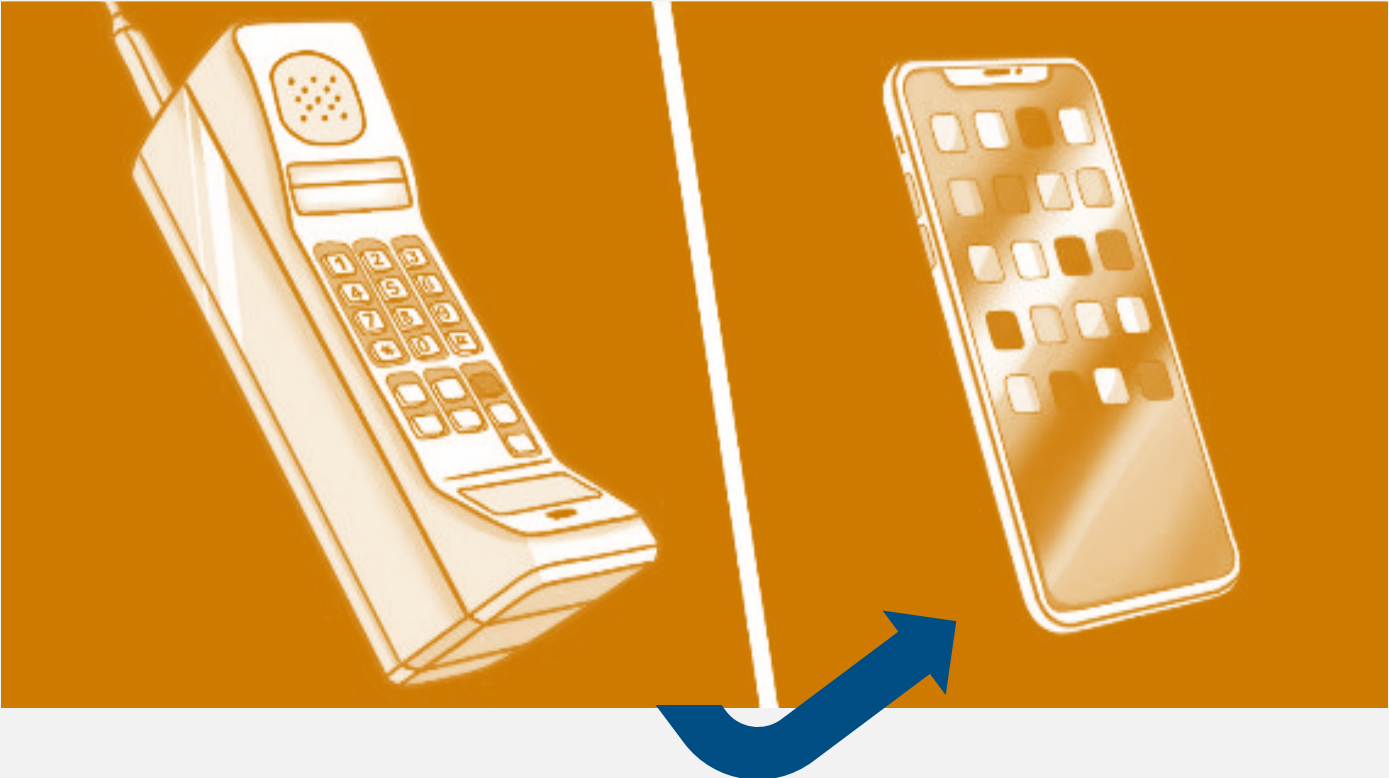

Public sector in the EU27
spends ~ 14% of GDP on
public procurement
Public procurement in the
Baltic Sea Region is even
bigger
This amounts to ~ €2 trillion



Cities could allocate part of their procurement budget to acquiring entirely new or significantly improved products/services (innovations), rather than existing ones

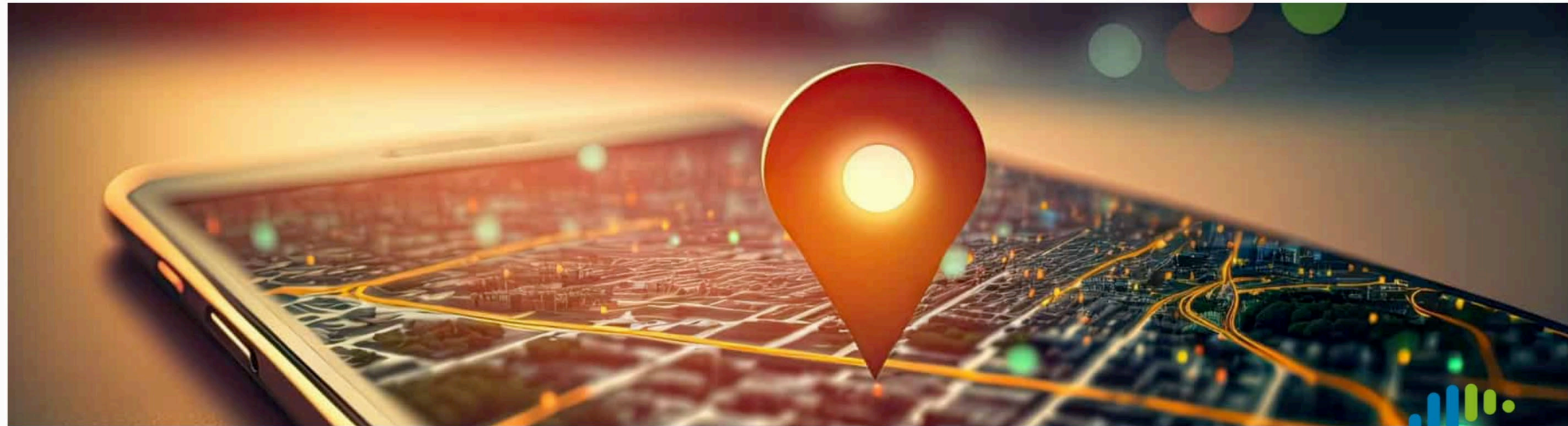
