Best practices implemented by members of the initiative:



Education



Recycling & upcycling



Example of implementation:

Reduction of energy consumption (detailed guidelines are described in a document developed by the Carbon Footprint Foundation, available from the organiser of the Krakow Film Festival).

Carbon footprint

Turning off all **Properly selected** equipment overnight Use of energy-Use of motion power of devices (e.g. (for events longer efficient lighting (LED) sensors in areas speakers, so that they than one day) during the event that do not need are not too powerful) to be lit constantly (hallways, bathrooms) Saving thermal Maximising the use of daylight energy through appropriate setting Optimisation of equipment of thermostats and space in terms of multiplication of equipment (e.g. one stage, multiple activities, reasonable choice of equipment)
