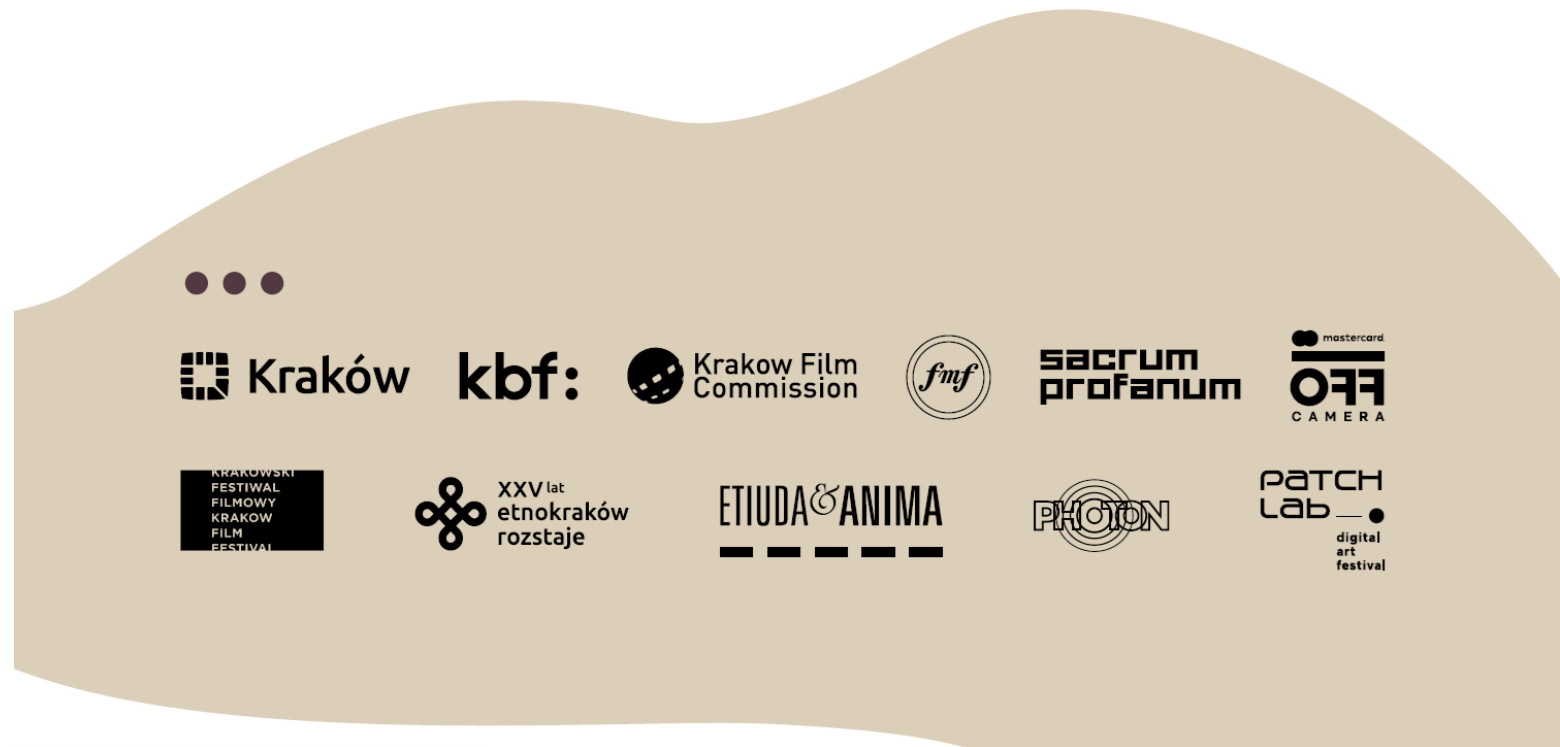

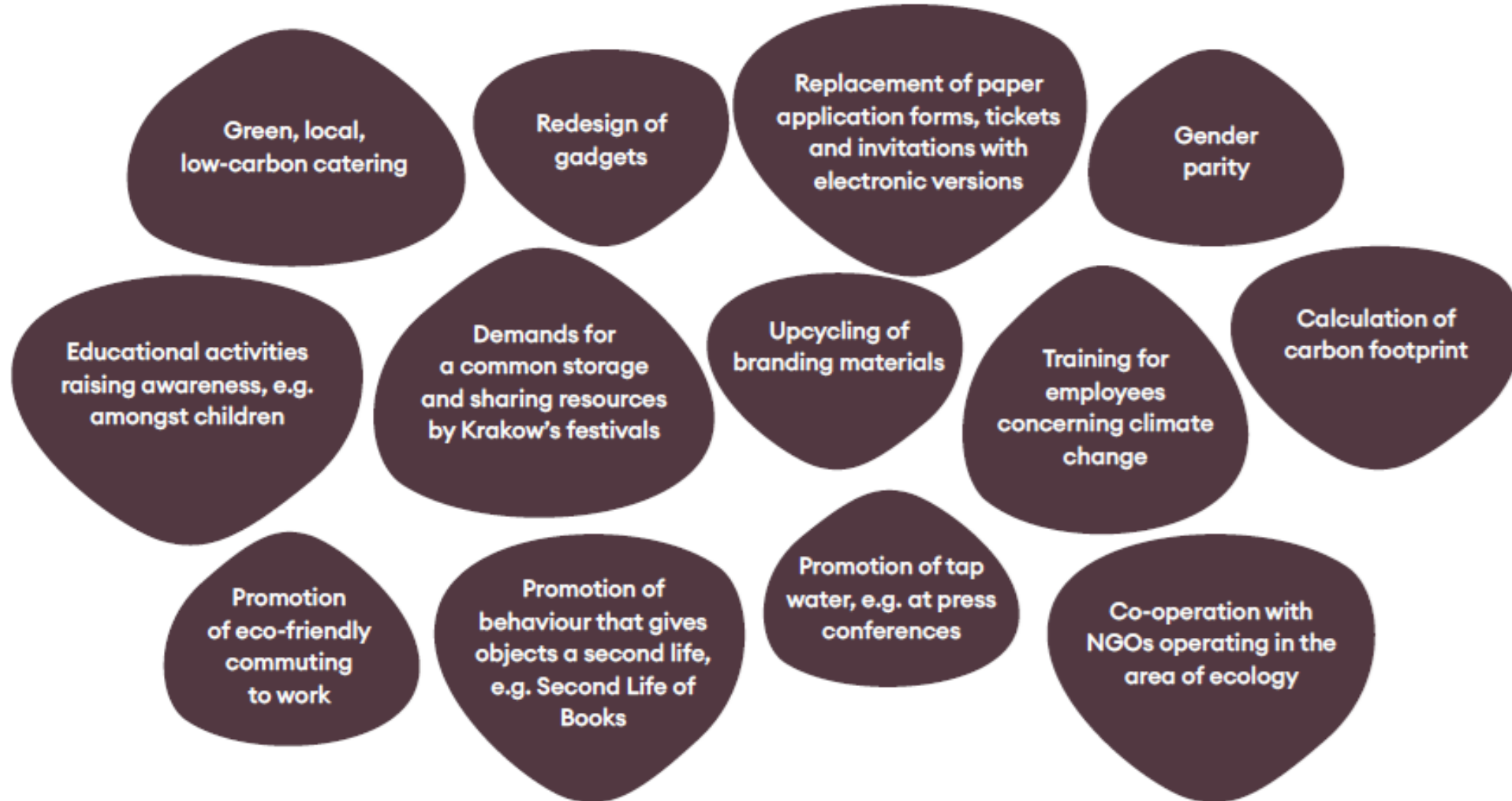

Implementation of the good practice

Example of implementation:

Reduction of energy consumption (detailed guidelines are described in a document developed by the Carbon Footprint Foundation, available from the organiser of the Krakow Film Festival).

Carbon footprint

Use of energy-efficient lighting (LED) during the event

Turning off all equipment overnight (for events longer than one day)

Properly selected power of devices (e.g. speakers, so that they are not too powerful)

Use of motion sensors in areas that do not need to be lit constantly (hallways, bathrooms)

Saving thermal energy through appropriate setting of thermostats

Maximising the use of daylight

Optimisation of equipment and space in terms of multiplication of equipment (e.g. one stage, multiple activities, reasonable choice of equipment)
