Study visit in Sevilla


A study visit for the OD4Growth project took place in Sevilla on May 21st and 22nd, 2024. The event, one of many technical visits, highlighted best practices from several countries, showcasing how Open Data applications improve citizens' daily lives, enhance tourism, and optimize public services.

The programme included speeches from key representatives about the importance of open data for local growth and innovation. Notable presentations included the high-detail Unified Digital Street Map of Andalusia and Seville's Tourism Intelligence System, as well as a keynote on the contribution of open data to local development, followed by a lively discussion on best practices and open data quality across regions.

In addition, the visit featured an assessment of initiatives proposed by the Andalusian Federation of Municipalities and Provinces (FAMP) as potential candidates for designation as OD4GROWTH best practices, as well as a knowledge-sharing activity aimed at understanding and selecting the proposal of good practices in relation to the three dimensions addressed by the project:

- Improving the quantitative and qualitative availability of OD, mainly by public institutions
- Improving the OD processing action to increase the quality standards of public services addressed to citizens in different fields.
- Improving the OD process to stimulate businesses and entrepreneurship with new products and services.

This collaborative approach will be fundamental in identifying and promoting best practices that can inspire and empower other territories to harness the transformative power of Open Data and respond to the challenges they face. By addressing these, the OD4GROWTH project continues to pave the way for a more connected, data-driven Europe.



Grand E-Nov + Local Event

Grand E-Nov +, our french partner, held a conference organized in collaboration with 'Filière Santé Numérique' and focusing on the theme "Using Territorial Data in Healthcare" on May 30th to explain how "Open Data could be used Support Healthcare as for a Coordination in Territories" and how indepth exploration of local open data can be used to develop a dashboard tool that allows healthcare coordination actors to access information on healthcare professionals in their area.

Discussions during the event led to the identification of new beneficiaries and the establishment of contact with the National Health Agency (ARS). It also confirmed the interest of our targets in the dashboard we developed for health coordinators using the ANS open data database.

On July 3, 2024, key territorial actors gathered in Córdoba, Spain, to discuss the progress of the OD4GROWTH project.


This meeting served as a platform to share updates and outline the next steps in our effort to enhance public services through open data.

Stakeholders' meeting in Greece


On July 17, 2024, key territorial actors gathered online to discuss the progress of the OD4GROWTH project.

The meeting began with a review of the 3rd semester activities, highlighting workshops and training sessions aimed at improving data literacy.

During the event, a detailed mapping of the project's three aspects, Public Authorities, Citizens and Businesses, was presented.

Key conclusions included the recognition of data importance, the need for innovative practices, internal regulations, prioritization of data-related activities, and training for public sector executives and businesses. Additionally, good practices from the OD4GROWTH project were presented and evaluated for local application.
