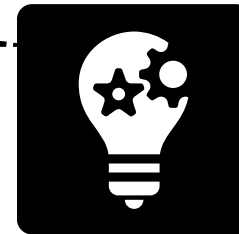
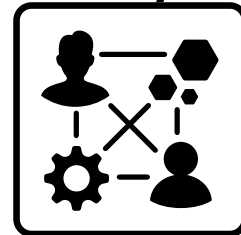

# Peer review: Framing the Urban Logistics Strategy

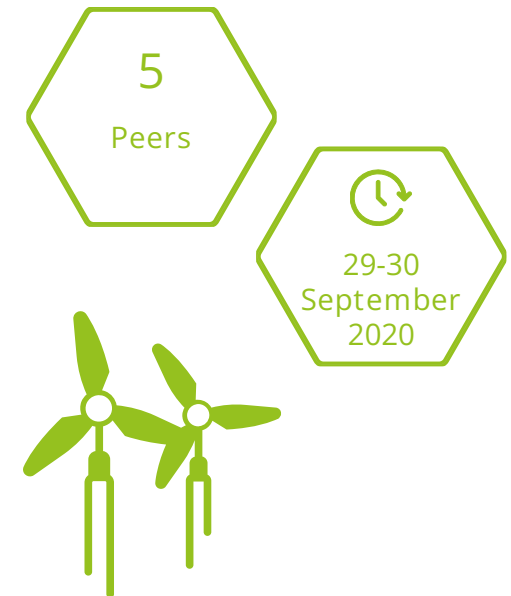
## ► City of Warsaw, Poland

- Formulate clear and ambitious city goal possible to quantify
- Create a core team responsible for the success of implementing the Sulp
- Develop a collaborative business model
- Show a good practices and approach by public projects
- Implement a system of incentives and disincentives for business

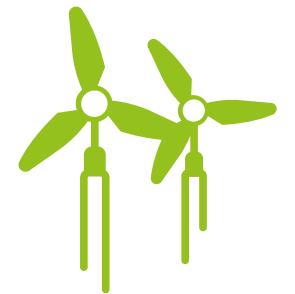

Recommendations:

- Low emission zones should be integrated into SUMP
- Have a dynamic approach to vehicle restrictions (to become stricter over time), focus on removing diesel vehicle
- Multi-level approach to communication – national one-stop-shop + local information
