- 1857 first organised public utility service in Maribor
- 1952 post war growth of the city / urbanisation of the city
- 1960 public utility company renamed to NIGRAD
- 1999 Nigrad becomes acredited for laboratory activities
- 2018 Nigrad becomes EU DEMO partner for transition to CE























Nigrad

Cleaned illegal dumps


Revitalized degraded area

Bank of materials

- Green concrete blocks for seperation of materials
- Collecting construction waste materials except land excavation (due to spatial restraints)



Digital material passport





The Material Digital Passport is a tool that encapsulates detailed information about materials, providing transparency and traceability throughout its lifecycle. This passport serves as a critical component in supply chain collaboration, offering an extensive database of material origins, properties, processing methods, and end-of-life options.

National situation:

- 2022 Zakon o varovanju okolja (2)
 - only defines what is construction waste
- 2008 Uredba o ravnanju z odpadki, ki nastajajo pri gradbenih delih
 - mostly deals with excavated land
 - waste can be stored temporarily at the site
 - an official company collecting construction waste must take the waste from construction sites (over 200 small companies)

Maribor, 16.03.2023

DECREE – in power since May 1st, 2023

Article 15: Providing opinion building permits and connection to existing public road infrastructure;

Article 16: Authorization for inert construction waste + "other elements declared by the public service provider or representative of the city municipality" at the demolition site

Article 17: In charge of public cadastre of public infrastructure on this decree

Article 18: Municipal inspection is charged with monitoring and regulating the implementation of the decree

What changed for Nigrad?

Based on the city decree, Nigrad is the only company in the municipality of Maribor, to which the constructors can bring waste removed from the construction site of public construction projects, and at the same time, they have to give consent for the permit for demolition and construction, so they know what materials are present at the demolition/construction site.



Next steps

- Obtaining neighbouring land
- Expanding to neighbouring municipalities
