Once you have your registration number, just add it to your listing and you'll be done registering.

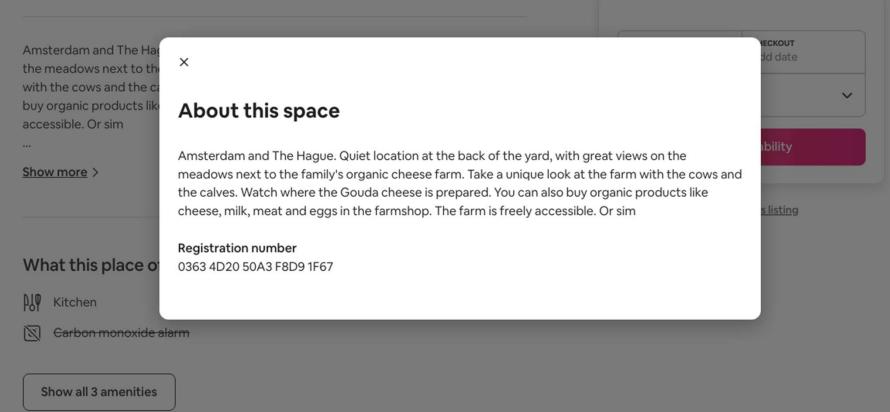
