


Peer review: Early school leaving and integration of NEETS into the labour market

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Labour market integration

- Two major trends:
 - The Ukrainian refugee crisis is the largest in Europe since WWII, with 4.3 million UA refugees recorded in EU
 - In the first ten months of 2023 alone, nearly a million asylum applications were submitted, marking a 21.3% increase from the previous year and the highest number since 2016.
- Migrants face various barriers to integration, including language and cultural unfamiliarity, uncertain residency status, insufficient education and housing options, and mismatches between skills and local job markets.
- Effective integration into the labor market is key, as it **reduces dependence on social services and fosters broader societal integration**.
- Migrants bring valuable skills and experiences, potentially revitalizing regions facing
 population decline and brain drainCity and municipal governments play a crucial role
 in providing services and engaging with diverse communities.

- Projects working on migration: MILEstone, SIRM, SALAM, INVOLVIM
- Projects focusing on the labour market and employment: MICROFUTURE, WeSTEMEU, SECON, atWork4NEETs, RuralYouthFuture, RESEES, YESVolunteer
