HIPÂ are **showrooms** like apartment dedicated to well being for elderly people living at home or in care establishments (nursing homes). It is open to public and equipped with the last solutions and innovations linked to the dimensions of well ageing:

- Nutrition
- Security
- Wellbeing and social abilities
- Mobility and adaptability (housing)

HIPÂ apartments are based in Hauts-de-France area. It could be visited individually or collectively all year long thanks to an animator who knows all the products and solutions and the interests for visitors.

In 2021 a virtual visit capability has been added to the offer to have a more wider visitor indicators.


