

- Social: Enhancing inclusivity, quality of life, and community governance.









BUDGET AND FUNDING STRUCTURE

Total Budget: €15 million for 2023-2030, funded by:

- EU and National Grants: 60%
- Regional Partnerships: 25%
- Local Contributions: 15%

Annual Allocations:

- Renewable energy: €2.5 million
- Sustainable mobility: €1 million
- Green spaces: €1.5 million

Funding Partners: Collaborations with Generalitat Valenciana, local businesses, and EU programmes, ensuring sustained financial support











TRANSFERABILITY POTENTIAL

The Serà 2030 model is transferable to other regions of Europe, with adaptable pillars:

- **Green Infrastructure:** Urban greening and renewable energy projects. >1.
- **Community-Driven Governance:** Encouraging participatory initiatives >1. through local associations.
- Sustainable Transport: Expanding cycling networks and public transport >1. access.
