The project was launched in March 2023 with a kick-off meeting hosted by the Leading Partner – the University of Zaragoza, Spain.

The consortium partners travelled from Finland, Romania, France, Lithuania, Italy, Ireland, and the Netherlands and were welcomed by Vice-Rector of Innovation and Technology Transfer at the University of Zaragoza, Gloria Cuenca Bescós, and Yolanda Sancho Serrano, Head of Universities Department, Government of Aragon. Also in attendance were local business leaders from the Aragon region, many of whom were examples of successful spin-offs and beneficiaries of local government support.

The partners also got to visit the CEMINEM Research and Development lab in Zaragoza and the Spin-up Business Incubator as well as the ground-breaking ETOPIA Center for Art and Technology.

In early June 2023, the partners and invited local stakeholders, met in Timisoara (Romania), the European Capital of Culture 2023, for the 1st Inter-Regional Thematic Workshop (IRTW), and 2nd Inter-Regional Study Visit (IRSV). The event comprised of two days of sessions focused on promoting the entrepreneurial culture among key stakeholders of various European regions.

Multiple sessions and presentations provided a space for discussion among policy makers, university representatives, investors, entrepreneurs and legal experts. The event gave participants a deeper insight into the do's and don'ts of spin-offs. From an 'Ideathon' at the University of Zaragoza, to start-up talks and innovation sessions on translating scientific knowledge into business in Alsace, France, local good practices were shared for an inspiring knowledge exchange between project partners.

The experience was enriched with local cultural activities such as a city tour of Timisoara, the European Capital of Culture 2023 and a tour of the Nokia Romania Headquarters.
