



On 13 and 14 September 2023, the Policy Learning Platform hosted a peer review together with the City of Magdeburg on the topic of governance and digitalisation of fortress heritage. Discover the recommendations.



Promoting gender inclusive urban planning policies in Valenciennes Métropole

The Policy Learning Platform conducted a peer review for Valenciennes Métropole, France, held on 17-18 April 2024. Valenciennes Métropole sought inspiration to promote gender inclusive urban policies, namely regarding the process to involve stakeholders in a gender mainstreaming approach.



Creating a star-gazing destination in Rasinari

On 10-11 October 2024, the Policy Learning Platform held an onsite reverse peer review for the Municipality of Rasinari, Romania, which requested advice regarding their policy challenge on creating a star-gazing destination in the vicinity of their Natura 2000 site.

Citizen Science for Policy

Citizen science initiatives connect citizens and scientists to collaboratively engage in research across various stages and levels of involvement, from co-designing research agendas and policies to co-creating and co-assessing scientific knowledge (<u>European Commission</u>).

This method serves as a valuable tool for citizen engagement, enabling participants to learn more about specific fields or issues, provide evidence, inform policy or decision-making, and address gaps in research.

The benefits of citizen science in policy formulation and implementation are significant, ranging from generating evidence for assessments and supporting regulatory compliance to fostering community empowerment and raising awareness.



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
