What benefits can you expect?

Relation with the joint secretariat (JS)

- Lead partner (LP) principle
- Each project monitored by two people in the JS

Policy officer

Finance officer

• **Communication** officer for questions related to project communication and website (hosted by the programme)

Ready?

- 1. Project approved on 10 December 2024 (eligibility of expenditure)
- 2. Conditions fulfilled by 14 March 2025
- 3. Project starts on 1 May 2025
- 4. Subsidy contracts signed quickly
- 5. Partnership agreement signed quickly (partners need to sign to report costs)

Monitoring tools


- Progress report (PR)
- Project's website
 (including good practices section)
- Exchange with LP upon need (email, video calls)
- Mid-term review meeting (beginning of 2027)
- JS participation in the project's final conference



Online monitoring system

Reporting and monitoring in the Portal

- Progress report
- Formal changes of application form (request for changes)
 - Partnership change
 - Budget change above 20% flexibility rule
 - Integration of pilot action after midterm review




Reporting periods and deadlines

Progress report	Reporting period	Deadline for submission
First (= PR1)	10/12/2024 – 31/10/2025	01/02/2026 (= 3 months after the end of the reporting period)
PR2	01/11/2025 – 30/04/2026 (six months)	01/08/2026
PR3	01/05/2026 – 31/10/2026 (six months)	01/02/2027
PR4	01/11/2026 – 30/04/2027 (six months) Midterm review	01/08/2027
PR5	01/05/2027 – 31/10/2027 (six months)	01/02/2028
PR6	01/11/2027 – 30/04/2028 (six months)	01/08/2028
PR7	01/05/2028 – 31/10/2028 (six months)	01/02/2029
Last (= PR8)	01/11/2028 – 31/07/2029 (nine months)	31/07/2029 (= end of the project = end date of eligibility)

Reporting procedure


- 1. LP coordinates the preparation of the PR with the partners
- 2. LP submits PR to JS
- 3. JS checks and sends back clarification requests
- 4. LP submits revised PR and replies to the clarifications
- 5. JS approves PR when all requests clarified
- 6. Accounting body transfers funds to LP (1 month)
- 7. LP transfers funds to partners quickly
