Danube towns Komarno - Komarom

Komarno Slovakia 35 000 inhabitants

Komarom Hungary 20 000 inhabitants

Annual festival since 1990 Komarom Days

1 week starting from April 26th (commemorating victory in 1849)

Cultural and built heritage highlighted during the festival

Fortress system built for 200 000 soldiers by the Habsburgs

Organisers: 2 municipalities, around 50 NGOs,



Tata Hungary

Series of annual festivals inspired by history and nature

Patara Turkish siege of the castle in Tata

Folk Days

Water Music Flowers Festival around the lake (100 000 visitors)

Wild goose festival (60 000 wild geese on the lake of Tata)

Organisers: Municipality, NGOs, schools

Komárom – Komárno Days Slovakia - Hungary



- 2 states 1 city Annual festival on both sides of the Danube
